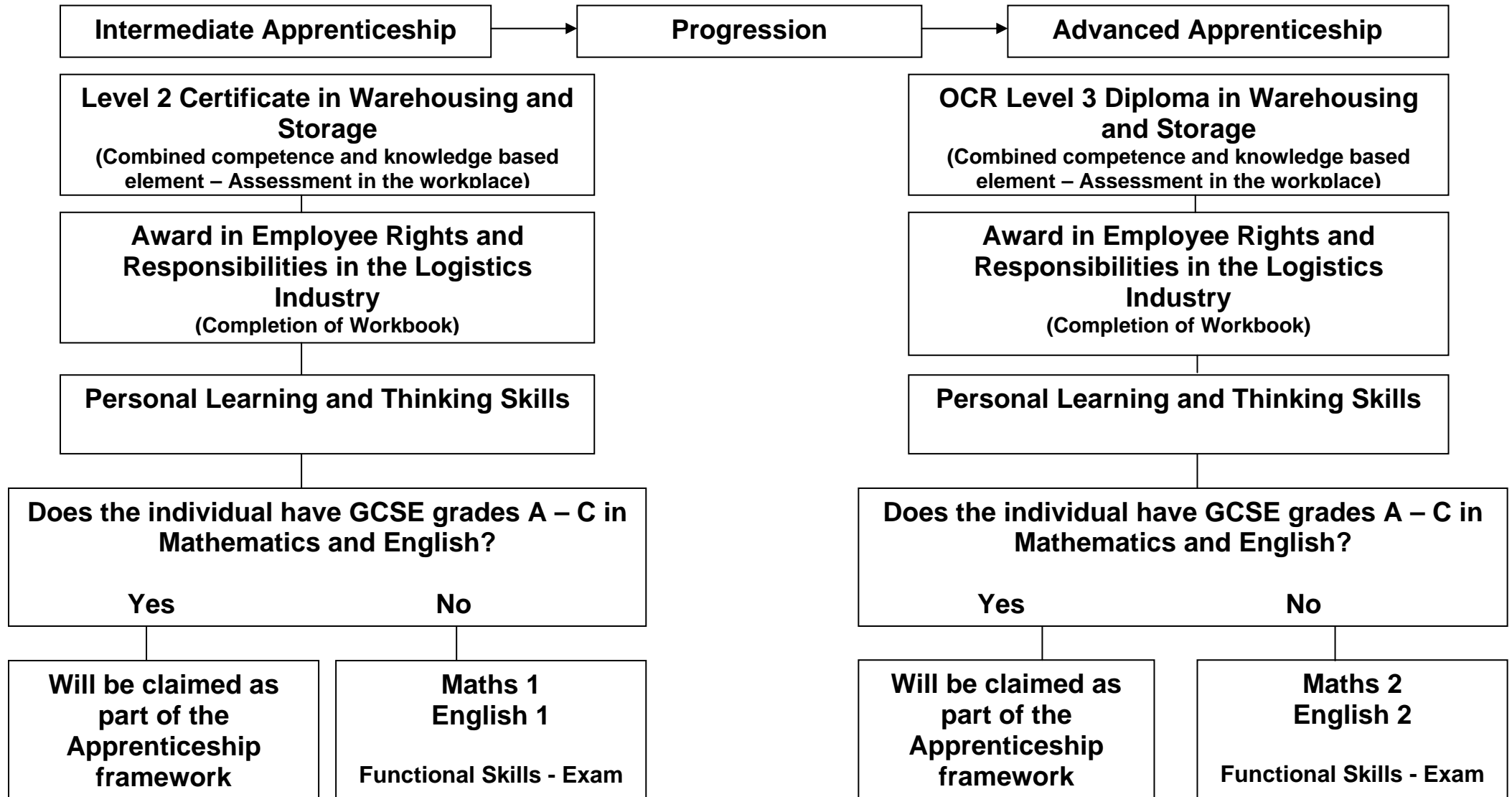


Warehousing & Storage Apprenticeship Framework

(As guidance for completion the level 2 or level 3 framework can take up to 12 months each, depending on experience and existing qualifications)



Enhancement to programme training available:

Apprentices are advised to attend our Bite Size range of training sessions which are held at UCMK, CMK. All sessions last for 90 minutes and are designed to provide knowledge around the NVQ mandatory units as well as the Technical Certificate.

What is an Apprenticeship?

An Apprenticeship is a mix of real work and learning. Apprentices earn a wage and get experience whilst working towards a number of qualifications. An Apprenticeship follows a Level 2 programme and can lead onto an Advanced Apprenticeship which is a Level 3 programme.

There are a number of elements to each Apprenticeship and this is called the framework. Each Apprenticeship framework has four main strands:

- Competence based strand
- Technical strand
- Personal learning and thinking skills (PLTS)
- Functional Skills

The four strands are sometimes accompanied by additional qualifications to give the most relevant skills and knowledge required for the job.

Duration

Up to 12 months for a level 2 and a further 12 months for a level 3 depending on previous experience and qualifications.

Location

Mainly delivered and assessed in the workplace with the opportunity to attend training events relevant to the Apprenticeship. Selection of training will be dependent on individual development and business needs.

The level 2 Certificate is aimed at: Individuals who undertake varied warehousing, storage and logistics activities at an operative level. The qualification is about the safe and efficient receipt, movement, storage, handling and dispatch of goods in a warehousing and logistics environment.

The level 3 Diploma is aimed at: Working as a Senior Member of the warehouse team, in addition to your normal warehouse operation activities, you will also have delegated responsibility for overseeing the correct selection and packing of customer orders, ensuring the team complete these tasks on time ready for despatch.
