

Enrolling students who do not meet standard eligibility criteria but live in a SEEDA SOA

If you have a student who wants to enrol on a course but does not meet standard eligibility criteria, if they live in one of the Routes to Success SOA's (see list below), they could be funded through the SEEDA project.

In this instance, get the learner to complete the enrolment form in the usual way and ensure that they complete a SEEDA tracking form.

Once they have filled in the forms, in the 'sponsorship' section of the enrolment form, write "SEEDA". Fill in the course title, start date and end date etc. but **leave the course code blank.**

Send the enrolment form to Chaffron Way for the attention of Graham Eaton and send the tracking form (and a copy of the enrolment form) to the Routes to Success team at Woughton Skills Ladder.
