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National lockdown position / Localised lockdown

## Campus Students

Majority of students to continue their usual timetables via online learning. A small number of students linked to key workers will continue to access College.

Students will continue their learning online. Those requiring exams or physical technical assessment to have limited access to College (you will be notified if this applies to you).

Students will return to MK College campus for lessons that focus mainly on the practical aspects of their course. The majority of the knowledge element will continue to be delivered online.

Students will return to MK College campus for the mix of onsite lessons with opportunities to continue learning online. Likely staggered start and finish times to support with social distancing.

Full return to MK College for most, with some sessions still delivered online.

## What you can expect from us...

Full access to all college support service and course tutors online, taking advantage of the latest innovations in online learning.

Full access to college support services and course tutors online. We will only bring you into college where it is essential for you to pass your qualification. These will be for single sessions with enhanced social distancing and no food / wider college services available.

Mixture of face to face and online learning with smaller class sizes, one way systems in corridors and enhanced social distancing measures to ensure safe learning. Limited food and wider college services available.

Mixture of face to face learning with timetables designed to reduce class sizes and promote social distancing. Return of full on site college services.

All classes will follow a 'new normal' mixed timetable with staggering of lunch and break times to aid social distancing and full return of on site college services.

## Highly vulnerable / shielding students

Please advise us on your application or at interview if you are vulnerable to Coronavirus or are currently shielding. As part of your interview we will explore how we can meet your needs and allow you to have a full student experience whilst keeping you safe.

## Work experience / industry placements

Making sure all students are able to access work experience where it forms part of their qualification remains a key aspiration. Work experience may continue to be in person or via online channels however it will continue to offer a real experience of the sector within your chosen industry.

## Apprenticeships

Interviewing, recruitment and ongoing assessments will all be conducted online working with your employer to ensure you can continue your learning.

The majority of learning for apprentices will continue online with access to the college campus to prepare for End Point Assessments, and for specific assessments which are unable to be performed remotely.

Phased return to learning at our campuses in agreement with your employer. Session times staggered to aid social distancing

Team to return to campus working on a rota'd basis. External meetings to return but preference for online meetings / assessments.

Majority of apprentices to return to learning at our campuses. Meetings with apprentice employers may continue online depending on their preference
